NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1968 HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The North Yorkshire County Council Footpath No. 15 Malham Moor Diversion Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order, made on 12th March 1982 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, or to be confirmed, as an unopposed Order by the North Yorkshire County Council.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert the public right of way known as Footpath No. 15 Malham Moor. The section of Footpath to be diverted commences at a point at Grid Reference 899 705 being on the road. It passes through the farmyard and across the middle of three meadows to cross Cowside Beck where the stream has altered its course and isolated the old clapper bridge.

The section of footpath to be created commences at a

point 50 metres west of the existing commencement point and runs through a wicket gate following the eastern side

of the field walls on higher ground to connect with a more stable approach to the proposed new bridge 50 metres up stream of the existing bridge.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at The Yorkshire Dales National Park Office, Colvend, Grasington near Skipton, North Yorkshire, during normal

Any representations or objections with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the County Solicitor, North Yorkshire County Council, County Hall, Northaller-ton, before 30th April 1982 and should state the grounds on which they are made.

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the North Yorkshire County Council may instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment, themselves confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted with the Order.
