#### MID GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

##### *Mid Glamorgan County Council (Richard Street, Cilfynydd) (Revocation) and (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1982*

Notice is hereby given that on 25th March 1982 the Mid Glamorgan County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be:

(1) To revoke "The Urban District of Pontypridd (Richard Street) Prohibition of Waiting Order 1974".

(2) To re-introduce the prohibition of waiting at any time on both sides of Richard Street, Cilfynydd, from its junction with Jones Street to a point opposite the division wall between Nos. 4 and 5, a distance of 22 yards, incorporating the additional under-mentioned exemptions:

(i) A disabled person's vehicle displaying the relevant disabled person's badge will be enabled to wait for a period of up to 2 hours with return prohibited within 1 hour.

(ii) Any vehicle will be enabled to wait for so long as may be reasonably necessary to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said sides of length of road.

(iii) Any vehicle will be enabled to wait outside premises on either side of the length of road for a reasonable period of time in connection with a wedding or funeral.

The Order came into operation on 2nd April 1982 and a copy thereof and a map showing the sides of length of road to which the Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Mid Glamorgan County Council, Cathays Park, Cardiff, during normal office hours until the end of 6 weeks from 2nd April 1982.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act as so amended or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from 2nd April 1982 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

#### MID GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

##### *Mid Glamorgan County Council (Morgan Street (Part), Pontypridd) (Variation and Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1982*

Notice is hereby given that on 22nd March 1982, the Mid Glamorgan County Council made an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as

amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effects of which are as hereunder:

(i) to vary the "Mid Glamorgan County Council (Pontypridd-Central Area) (Traffic Regulation) Order No. 1 1979" by the deletion of the provision therein which limits the waiting of vehicles to a period not exceeding 1 hour with return prohibited within 2 hours on the eastern side of Morgan Street, Pontypridd from a point 23 metres (25 yards) north of its junction with Bridge Street northwards for a distance of 46 metres (51 yards);

(ii) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on that section of Morgan Street, Pontypridd described in (i) above.

Exemptions are provided in the Order for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, building and roadworks, the maintenance of essential services, weddings, funerals and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office. Disabled persons' vehicles displaying the relevant disabled persons' badge are allowed to wait for up to 2 hours with return prohibited within 1 hour.

The Order came into operation on 2nd April 1982 and a copy thereof and a map showing the side of length of road to which the Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Mid Glamorgan County Council, Cathays Park, Cardiff, during normal office hours until the end of 6 weeks from 2nd April 1982.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act as so amended or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from 2nd April 1982, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

#### GRAVESHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

##### *The Gravesham Borough Council (School Lane, Chequers Street, Chalk Road and Steadman Close, Higham) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Consolidation) Order 1982*

Notice is hereby given that the Gravesham Borough Council as agents of the Kent County Council have made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 1st April 1982 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
