Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Hereford and Worcester propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and of all enabling powers the effect of which will be:

- to prohibit waiting at any time on that side and sides of lengths of road in the City of Worcester in the County of Hereford and Worcester as described in the First Schedule to this notice;
- (2) to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Monday to Saturday inclusive on the side of length of road in the City of Worcester in the County of Hereford and Worcester as described in the Second Schedule to this notice.

Exemptions in the proposed Order will permit waiting for the purpose of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading and unloading goods;
- (c) delivering and collecting mail by Post Office vehicles;
- (d) delivering and collecting furniture and effects with Police consent;
- (e) any building or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the supply of gas, electricity and water and maintenance of telegraphic lines;

(f) the fire brigade, ambulance or police services. Exemptions in the Order also permit disabled persons' vehicles displaying a badge and parking disc issued under the Local Authority's Orange Badge Scheme:

- (a) to wait on the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule to this notice for a maximum of 2 hours (return prohibited within 1 hour).
- (b) to wait at any time on the length of road specified in the Second Schedule.
