*The Borough of Surrey Heath (London Road (A30)/Staff College, Camberley) (Prohibition of Right Turn) Order 1981.*

Notice is hereby given that the Surrey Heath Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Surrey County Council under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1974 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with section 84C (1) of the Act of 1967 have made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit vehicles proceeding in a westerly direction along the London Road (A30) from making a right-hand turn at the Park Street traffic lights into the eastern entrance to the Staff College, Camberley.

##### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

*The East Sussex (Crowhurst Road, Hastings) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1982.*

#### TENDRING DISTRICT COUNCIL

*The Tendring District Council (Walton-on-the-Naze) (Experimental One-Way Traffic System and No Waiting) Order 1982.*

Notice is hereby given that the Tendring District Council propose to make an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, (as amended), with regard to Alfred Terrace, High Street, Old Pier Street and The Parade, Walton-on-the-Naze.

When the Order comes into operation no one will be permitted to drive along:

- (a) *High Street*, from its junction with Old Pier Street to The Parade other than in an easterly direction;
- (b) *Old Pier Street*, from The Parade to High Street other than in a westerly direction;
- (c) *The Parade*, from High Street to Old Pier Street other than in a south-westerly direction.

In conjunction with the imposition of this experimental one-way working, waiting restrictions in Alfred Terrace, High Street, Old Pier Street and The Parade, Walton-on-the-Naze will be varied.

The proposed experimental Order will continue in operation for a period of 6 months.

#### THANET DISTRICT COUNCIL

*The Thanet District Council (Gordon Road and Stanley Road, Cliftonville, Margate, Kent) (Prohibition of Right and Left Turns) Order 1982.*
