## NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971, SECTION 210

*The London Borough of Tower Hamlets (Drivers Buildings) Public Path Stopping-up Order 1982*

Notice is hereby given that the above-mentioned Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") made on 25th March 1982, is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed by the London Borough of Tower Hamlets as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to stop up the whole of the path known as Drivers Buildings E.1 situate at the rear of 213-231 Mile End Road E.1.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at Room 212, Legal Department, Town Hall, Patriot Square, Bethnal Green, E2 9LN and may be inspected free of charge during normal office hours, Mondays to Fridays.

Any representation or objection with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the Legal Department, London Borough of Tower Hamlets, Town Hall, Patriot Square, not later than 7th May 1982, and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets may, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, themselves confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for confirmation any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent to the Secretary of State with the Order.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119

*Borough Council of Calderdale, The Calderdale Footpath No. 54 (Part) (Halifax) Public Footpath Diversion Order 1981.*

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order made on 28th October 1981, is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Department of the Environment and Transport for confirmation or to be confirmed as an unopposed Order by the Borough Council of Calderdale. The effect of the Order if confirmed without modification will be to divert the public right of way over land situate at Lower Ellistones, Greetland, shown by a bold black line on the map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule. A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Halifax between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on weekdays. Any representations or objections with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the Chief Administrative Officer, Borough Council of Calderdale, Town Hall, Halifax, before 30th April 1982 and should state the grounds on which it is made. If no representations or objections are duly made or if any were made and withdrawn the Borough Council of Calderdale may, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for confirmation, themselves confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted with the Order.

## SCHEDULE

*Part A.* That part of Footpath No. 54 (Elland) running from point "A" across land at Lower Ellistones, Greetland, in a north-easterly direction, ending approximately 54 metres from that point (3 feet wide, (marked AB on the map annexed to the Order).

*Part B.* The alternative way to be provided traverses from point "B" at Ellistones Lane in a south-westerly direction for approximately 53 metres to rejoin Footpath No. 54 at point "A" (3 feet wide).

*The Hampshire (Hart District No. 17) (Parish of Mattingley) Public Path Creation Order 1979*

Notice is hereby given that on 18th March 1982, the Secretary of State for the Environment confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to create the public right of way in the Parish of Mattingley described in the Schedule hereto.

The Order becomes operative as from 15th April 1982, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he may under paragraph 2 of the Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 2nd April 1982, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
