NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1968 HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

*The North Yorkshire County Council Footpath No. 36
Horton-in-Ribblesdale Diversion Order 1978*

Notice is hereby given that on 18th January 1982 the Secretary of State for the Environment confirmed, with modifications the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order, as confirmed, is to divert the public right of way known as Footpath No. 36 in the parish of Horton-in-Ribblesdale. The section of existing footpath commences at a point in the centre of Brackenbottom, Horton-in-Ribblesdale at Grid Ref. SD 81687214. The path runs in an easterly direction through O.S. Fields Nos. 418, 420, 421, 371, 369 and Gavel Rigg to end at the Parish Boundary at Grid Ref. SD 83527259 having covered a total distance of 2012 metres. The section of footpath to be created commences at the northern end of Brackenbottom at Grid Ref. SD 81687226 the path runs in an easterly direction on the southern side of the northern walls of O.S. Field Nos. 420, 371, 369 and Gavel Rigg at distances from these walls as dimensioned on a plan attached hereto and marked "Plan referred to in the North Yorkshire County Council dated 18th January 1982". The Path then crosses the Parish boundary on to Fawcett Moor to join the Pennine Way at Grid Ref. SD 83627275 having covered a total distance of 2062 metres.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the map contained in it has been deposited at the Yorkshire Dales National Park Office, Colvend, Grassington, North Yorkshire, and may be inspected free of charge during normal office hours.

The Order becomes operative as from 18th January 1982 but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with

NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1968 HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

*The North Yorkshire County Council Footpath No. 24
Sneaton Diversion Order 1982*

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order, made on 22nd March 1982, is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, or to be confirmed, as an unopposed Order by the North Yorkshire County Council.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert the public footpath known as Footpath No. 24 Sneaton. The section of path to be diverted commences at Grid Ref. NZ 80 89430334 approximately 305 metres west of New May Beck Farm midway along the northern boundary of O.S. Field No. 3833. It proceeds in an easterly direction along the northern boundary of O.S. Field No. 3833 and into O.S. Field No. 5927 the path then enters O.S. Field No. 6030 along its northern boundary and into O.S. Field No. 6929 where it crosses the field to its eastern boundary at Grid Ref. NZ 80 89730329 at a point on the Sneaton Low Moor Road (Highway 137R). The total length of path to be diverted is 320 metres.

The section of new footpath commences at Grid Ref. NX 80 89430334 a point midway along the northern boundary of O.S. Field No. 3833 and then runs in an easterly direction for 79 metres or thereabouts to the eastern boundary of O.S. Field No. 3833. It then curves south crossing into O.S. Field No. 5927 and across to the south-western boundary and then to the southern tip of O.S. Field No. 5927 at Grid Ref. NZ 80 89530025 for approximately 91.5 metres to a point south of New May Beck Farm on highway 137R. The total length of the proposed path will be 170.5 metres.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at Whitby Library, Windsor Terrace, Whitby, North Yorkshire, during normal office hours.

Any representations or objections with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the County Solicitor, North Yorkshire County Council, County Hall, Northallerton, before 5th May 1982, and should state the grounds on which they are made.

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the North Yorkshire County Council may instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment, themselves confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted with the Order.
