The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under S.209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (County of South Yorkshire) (Sheffield No. 4) Order 1982", authorising the stopping up of a length of Coleridge Road, Sheffield.

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:—

1. An Order under sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980 providing:—

(a) that the slip roads he proposes to construct at Picket Post near Ringwood in the County of Hampshire shall become trunk roads as from the date when the Order comes into operation; and

(b) that part of the Folkestone-Honiton Trunk Road comprised of the service road to the petrol filling station south of that Trunk Road and east of Burley Road shall cease to be a trunk road as from the date the Secretary of State notifies the County Council of Hampshire (who will become the Highway Authority responsible for that part of the length) that the said new trunk roads are open for through traffic.

2. An Order under sections 12, 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising him:—

(a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter Burley Road (C10);

(b) to construct a new highway;

(c) to stop up private means of access to premises; and

(d) to provide new means of access to premises;

all at Picket Post aforesaid, and providing for the transfer of the said new highway to the County Council of Hampshire as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.

3. An Order under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 to close the gap in the central

reservation of the A31 trunk road which lies opposite the junction to Burley Road (C10) at Picket Post in the New Forest. It is intended that the proposed gap closure Order will become operative only after completion of the above improvement Scheme.

TRUNKING ORDER 198

(STONEY CROSS JUNCTION IMPROVEMENT)
(SIDE ROADS) ORDER 198

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:—

1. An Order under section 10 of the Highways Act 1980, the effect of which is to provide that:—

(a) a length of the C17 Fritham to Emery Down road which extends northwestwards from its junction with the northern side of the A31 for a distance of 45 metres (49 yards) and,

(b) a length of the C17 Fritham to Emery Down road which extends southeastwards from its junction with the south side of the A31 for a distance of 45 metres (49 yards),

shall become trunk roads as from the date the Order comes into operation; and

2. An Order under section 14 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising him:—

(a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways; and

(b) to construct a new highway

all at Stoney Cross in the County of Hampshire, and providing for the transfer of the said new highway to the County Council of Hampshire as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.

Copies of the draft Orders and of the relevant plans may be inspected at all reasonable hours from 14th April 1982 until 9th June 1982 or within 2 months from the date of publication of this notice, whichever period shall expire later, at the Department of Transport, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1 and at the offices of the Director (Transport) South Eastern Region, "Edgeborough", 74 Epsom Road, Guildford, Surrey; the Hampshire County Council, The Castle, Winchester and the New Forest District Council, Appletree Court, Lyndhurst, and Christchurch Road, Ringwood, Hampshire.
