(3) High Street and Well Street, Llandyssul (A486)	From a point 116 yards north of Graig Road junction with High Street to a point 33 yards north of its junction with Lon Letty
(4) Lon Letty	From its junction with Well Street to its junction with Church Street (B4476)
(5) Lon Wesley	From its junction with High Street at Bradford Square to its junction with New Road (B4476)
(6) New Road and Church Street (Cambrian Terrace) (B4476)	From a point 100 yards south-west of junction of New Road with Lon Wesley to a point 203 yards north of junction of Lon Letty with Church Street (Cambrian Terrace)
(7) New Road (B4476)	From its junction with Bridge Street to a point 33 yards north-east of this junction
(8) Zion Street	From its junction with High Street at Bradford Square for a length of 238 yards south-west of this junction (Greenhill Terrace)

(3) New Road from a point 33 yards north-east of its junction with Bridge Street to a point 100 yards south-west of its junction with Lon Wesley	West

- (3) New Road from a point 33 yards north-east of its junction with Bridge Street to a point 100 yards south-west of its junction with Lon Wesley. East

The Essex County Council (Colchester Road, Heybridge) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 the effect of which will be to impose the following waiting restrictions at Heybridge:

Waiting to be prohibited between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive

Colchester Road

Both Sides—from Hall Road north-eastwards to its south-western junction with Goldhanger Road, a total distance of approximately 267 metres.

Exceptions in the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of:

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers;
- (b) loading or unloading goods;

and where necessary, in connection with:

- (c) the maintenance of the road;
- (d) the supply of gas, electricity and water; and
- (e) the maintenance of Post Office services.
