NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A COMBINED LICENCE TO OBSTRUCT OR IMPEDE THE FLOW OF AN INLAND WATER BY MEANS OF IMPOUNDING WORKS AND TO ABSTRACT WATER AND FOR A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER FROM UNDERGROUND STRATA.

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Anglian Water Authority, Essex River Division by Messrs. G. T. Wright and Son, Brook Farm, Great Bentley (telephone Great Bentley 250430) for a combined licence to obstruct or impede the flow of a tributary of The Bentley Brook by means of an earth embankment to form a reservoir at National Grid map ref.
