## FIRST SCHEDULE

*Roads and lengths of roads in the Borough of Redditch in the County of Hereford and Worcester**Salters Lane*

- (1) from the roundabout at its junction with the Bromsgrove Highway (A448) to a point 125 metres (410 feet) south-west of its junction with Foxlydiate Crescent;
- (2) the roundabout at the eastern end of Salters Lane, its approach and egress roads including that length which connects with the north-west carriageway of the A448 Redditch to Bromsgrove Road.

*Middlepiece Drive*

- (1) from its westerly junction with Birchfield Road to its junction with Windmill Drive;
- (2) from its easterly junction with Birchfield Road to its junction with Windmill Drive.

*Middlehouse Lane* (B4184), from its junction with Windsor Road (B4184) to its junction with the Alvechurch Highway (A441).

## SECOND SCHEDULE

*Length of road in the Borough of Redditch in the County of Hereford and Worcester*

*Birmingham Road*, from a point 120 metres (393 feet) north of its junction with Clive Road, in a northerly direction, to a point 280 metres (918 feet) north of its junction with Windsor Road (B4184).

## THIRD SCHEDULE

*Roads and lengths of roads in the Borough of Redditch in the County of Hereford and Worcester*

*Windmill Drive*, from its junction with Evesham Road A448 to its northerly junction with the Bromsgrove Highway (A448) including the roundabout at the junction with Middlepiece Drive.

*Coldfield Drive*

- (1) from its junction with Rough Hill Drive/Alvechurch Highway (A441) northwards to its junction with the Lodge Park roundabout;
- (2) the roundabout at Lodge Park.

*Rough Hill Drive*, from its junction with The Slough A448 to its junction with Coldfield Drive/Alcester Highway.

*Holloway Drive*, from its junction with the Alvechurch Highway (A441) at Lodge Park to its junction with the Henley Highway (B4095), including the slip roads at this junction.

*Battens Drive* (B4497)

- (1) from its junction with the Warwick Highway (B4095) to its junction with the Coventry Highway (A4023);
- (2) the roundabout under the Coventry Highway (A4023).

*Paper Mill Drive*, from its junction with the roundabout at the Coventry Highway (A4023) to its junction with Icknield Street.

*Ravens Bank Drive*, from its junction with Icknield Street to the roundabout at its junction with the Coventry Highway (A4023).

*Moons Moat Drive*, from its junction with the roundabout at Ravens Bank Drive westwards to the roundabout at its junction with the Coventry Highway (A4023).

*Alders Drive*

- (1) from its junction with the roundabout at Warwick Highway (B4095) to its junction with the Coventry Highway (A4023);
- (2) the roundabout at its junction with Coventry Highway.

*Icknield Street Drive* (B4497), from the Ipsley Roundabout at its junction with the Warwick Highway (B4095) to a point 100 metres (328 feet) south-east of its junction with Washford Drive, a distance of 2,041 metres (6,699 feet).

*Warwick Highway* (B4095), from and including the Ipsley Roundabout at its junction with Icknield Street Drive (B4497) a distance of 1,595 metres (5,233 feet).

*Claybrook Drive*, from and including the Breaches Roundabout at its junction with the Warwick Highway (B4095) to and including the Washford Roundabout at its junction with Icknield Street Drive (B4497).

*Washford Drive*

- (1) from its junction with Icknield Street Drive (B4497) to its junction with Studley Road.
- (2) the roundabout at the junction of Studley Road, Woodrow Drive and Redditch Road.

*Woodrow Drive*

- (1) from its junction with Studley Road to its junction with Greenlands Drive;
- (2) the roundabout at the junction of Woodrow North and Greenlands Drive.

*Greenlands Drive*, from its junction with Woodrow Drive to its junction with Lodge Park.

*Lodge Park*, from its junction with Greenlands Drive to its junction with Holloway Drive.

Notice is hereby given that the Llanelli Borough Council on behalf of and with the authority of the Dyfed County Council, propose to make Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be as follows:

- (1) (a) To restrict the waiting of vehicles on the southern side of that length of Island Place between points 9 metres and 42 metres from the western end of the cul-de-sac therein to one hour with return prohibited within two hours between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday.
- (b) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on any day in the remainder of Island Place.
- (2) To re-introduce two-way traffic to Island Place.
- (3) To enable vehicles to turn left from Island Place into Park Street.
