IMPORTATION OF ANIMAL PRODUCTS AND POULTRY PRODUCTS ORDER 1980 (AS AMENDED)

Notice is hereby given that as provided by Article 4 of the Importation of Animal Products and Poultry Products Order 1980 (as amended) the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Welsh Office Agriculture Department have with effect from 26th March 1982 revoked the following General Licences for Denmark and replaced with new General Licences with amended conditions.

(1) Revoked Licences:

(A) Subject: Meat products (including fully cured pigmeat and dry sausage (including Salami)) and poultry meat products.

TAY/GEN/81/683 (In England) and WOAD/GEN/81/37 (In Wales).

(B) Subject: Fresh/refrigerated boneless beef or veal Fresh/refrigerated boneless/bone-in meat and offal derived from domestic solipeds (ie horse, ass, mule or hinny).

TAY/GEN/80/192 (In England) and WOAD/GEN/80/22 (In Wales).

(C) Subject: Fresh/refrigerated bone-in beef, veal, mutton or lamb. Fresh/refrigerated boneless mutton or lamb. Fresh/refrigerated offal (excluding pig offal).

TAY/GEN/80/193 (In England) and WOAD/GEN/80/30 (In Wales).

(D) Subject: Fresh/refrigerated pig meat and offal.

TAY/GEN/80/194 (In England) and WOAD/GEN/80/37 (In Wales).

(2) New General Licences to take effect from 26th March 1982 with product headings and conditions as detailed below:

A. Licence No. TAY/GEN/82/328 (In England) and WOAD/GEN/82/20 (In Wales).

Country: Denmark (excluding the island of Funen).

Subject of licence: Meat products (including fully cured pigmeat and dry sausage (including Salami)) and poultry meat products.

Licence A is valid for importation through

(a) all ports and airports in England, and

(b) all ports and airports in Wales.

Conditions attached to licence (A) above.

A. Each consignment must be accompanied by a certificate in accordance with the terms of the Council Directive on health problems affecting intra-Community trade in meat products 77/99 EEC signed by an official veterinarian of the Government of Denmark...

B. Any meat product imported under this licence shall be made available if so required for inspection by an Officer of the Ministry at any place nominated by him for such inspection. The importer or his agent shall afford all assistance necessary to such an officer to enable him to carry out the inspection in such a manner as he shall determine and the importer shall be responsible for meeting any costs of carrying out such an inspection.

C. With the exception of meat products which have been heat treated and contained in rigid hermetically sealed containers and poultry meat products the importation of meat products containing meat derived from animals originating on the island of Funen and from the establishments listed below is prohibited until further notice.

Subject: Fresh/refrigerated pig meat and pig offal.

Country: Denmark (excluding the island of Funen).

Licences B, C and D are valid for importation through:

Avonmouth, Dover (Eastern Dock), Felixstowe, Folkestone, Liverpool, Grimsby, Harwich (Parkestone Quay), London (Tilbury), Newhaven, Poole (cartoned meat only), Plymouth, Sheerness, Southampton (cartoned meat only), Tyne (North Shields), Heysham (cartoned meat only).

(b) *In Wales*

Cardiff.

Conditions attached to Licences B, C and D.

A. Each consignment must be accompanied by a certificate in accordance with the terms of the Council Directive on health problems affecting intra-Community trade in fresh meat 64/433 EEC as amended signed by an official veterinarian of the Government of Denmark.

B. Any meat or offal to which this licence refers must be transported to Great Britain in a sealed vehicle.

C. Any meat or offal imported under this licence shall be made available if so required for inspection by an Officer of the Ministry at any place nominated by him for such inspection. The importer or his agent shall afford all assistance necessary to such an officer to enable him to carry out the inspection in such a manner as he shall determine and the importer shall be responsible for meeting any costs of carrying out such an inspection.

D. With the exception of meat products which have been heat treated and are contained in rigid hermetically sealed containers the importation of fresh, chilled or frozen meat including bacon and ham, derived from animals originating on the island of Funen and from the establishments listed below is prohibited until further notice.
