## ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

### GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Greater Manchester County (Brunswick Street, Shaw) (Prohibition of Waiting) (County) Order 1981*

Notice is hereby given that the Greater Manchester County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time on:

Brunswick Street, Shaw, from its junction with Rochdale Road for a distance of 21 metres in a north-easterly direction.

The proposed Order contains exemptions to permit waiting for the purposes of boarding or alighting, loading or unloading, funerals, building operations or work on or under the length of road. Disabled persons' vehicles carrying a disabled person's badge will be allowed to wait for a period of up to 2 hours, return prohibited within 1 hour.
