

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The Suffolk County Council (Ipswich Star Lane/Waterworks Street) (Side Roads) Order 1981

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has confirmed the above Order which was made by the Suffolk County Council under section 14 of the Highways Act 1980 and which, as confirmed, authorises the Council:

- (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
- (b) to stop up highways,

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the classified road which the Council are proposing to construct between Star Lane and Waterworks Street, Ipswich.

Copies of the Order, as confirmed, and of the relevant plans may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours at the offices of the Suffolk County Council, County Hall, Ipswich, and at the Department of Transport, Eastern Regional Office, Heron House, 49-51 Goldington Road, Bedford.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 22nd April 1982 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

THE IMPORTED FOOD REGULATIONS 1968,
AS AMENDED

Denmark: Official Certificate

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Wales acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Imported Food Regulations 1968 (S.I. 1968 No. 97), as amended by the Imported Food (Amendment) Regulations 1973, 1979 and 1981 (S.I. 1973 No. 1351, S.I. 1979 No. 1426 and S.I. 1981 No. 1085) give notice that they hereby restrict recognition of the Official Certificate reproduced in the First Schedule to the notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 23rd April 1981 for the importation of poultry meat from Denmark to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

The Second Schedule to the notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 23rd April 1981 is hereby revoked.
