*The Lancashire County Council (Clayton Green District Centre Bus Turn-Round, Chorley Borough) (Prohibition of Driving and Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1982*

Notice is hereby given, that the Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

- (1) Prohibit any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in the First Schedule to this notice, except for certain exemptions which are set out in the Order, and
- (2) Prohibit any motor vehicle to wait, at any time, on the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule to this notice except for certain exemptions set out in the Order.

#### FIRST SCHEDULE

*Length of road at Clayton Green, in the Borough of Chorley*

The bus turn-round, a distance of approximately 100 metres situated on the north and west of the un-named access road, which leads north from Clayton Green to the Clayton Green District Centre.

That length of the Burscough-Parbold-Wrightington Road, A5209, from a point approximately 360 metres west of its junction with the B5375 to a point approximately 400 metres east of its junction with the B5375. (726)

#### GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Greater Manchester County (Gathurst Road, B5206, Orrell) (Prohibition of Waiting) (County) Order 1981*

Notice is hereby given that on 14th April 1982, the Greater Manchester County Council, made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting at all times on both sides of Gathurst Road, Orrell, from a point opposite the southerly kerblines of Derwent Road to a point 150 metres north of the junction with Orrell Road (A577).

The Order contains exemptions to permit waiting for the purposes of boarding or alighting, loading and unloading, funerals, building operations or work on or under the lengths of road. In addition, disabled person's vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc, will be allowed to wait for up to 2 hours, return prohibited within 1 hour.

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 3rd May 1982, and a plan showing the road to which it relates, may be inspected between 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays at:

- (a) the County Legal Office, County Hall (Room 313, Minshull Street Entrance), Piccadilly Gardens, Manchester.
- (b) the Director of Administration's Office, Wigan Borough Council, Civic Centre, Millgate, Wigan.
- (c) Orrell District Office, Council Offices, Orrell Road, Orrell.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks from 14th April 1982, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

#### NORTHAMPTONSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Northamptonshire County Council (Various Road Junctions, Finedon) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order*

Notice is hereby given that on 15th April 1982, the Northamptonshire County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at all times on the lengths of road at Finedon specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions in the Order permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods and, where necessary, in connection with the maintenance of roads and the supply of gas, electricity and water. The usual exemptions apply to disabled person's vehicles bearing the relevant badge.
