

mammals inspected before and after death in the country of origin of the meat and passed in accordance with criteria satisfactory to the Ministers; and

(b) that the dressing, packing and other preparation of the meat was carried out with all necessary precautions for the prevention of danger to health.

The said Official Certificate is recognised subject to the following conditions:

(i) Recognition applies only to fresh meat imported from Botswana.

(ii) Where the Official Certificate is in the form of a label, recognition will apply only if the label is securely affixed to the meat or the package containing the meat, and if the label has not in any other circumstances or on any other occasion been used as an Official Certificate.

(iii) Where the Official Certificate is in the form of a stamp, recognition will apply only if the stamp is clearly impressed or otherwise marked on the meat or the package containing the meat.

(iv) Recognition of the Official Certificate is restricted to the extent indicated in the Schedule hereto.

Recognition of the Official Certificate described in the Schedule to the notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 22nd May 1981 is restricted to canned meat products only (excluding those derived in whole or in part from poultry meat).

The notices published in the *London Gazette* dated 21st September 1972, 22nd October 1974 and 14th November 1978 are hereby revoked.

#### SCHEDULE

For specified fresh meat, the Official Certificate shall consist of an oval mark 6.5 cm wide, by 4.5 cm high. The following information must appear on the mark in perfectly legible characters:

On the upper part, **BOTSWANA** in capitals or, if appropriate the set of initials approved under the International Convention on Motor Vehicle Registration, viz: **BD**.

In the centre; the veterinary approval number of the slaughterhouse, viz: Est 1.

On the lower part, the word **APPROVED**.

The letters must be 0.8 cm high and the figures 1 cm high. The mark may include an indication of the official veterinarian who carried out the health inspection of the meat.

NOTE. Imports of meat and meat products from certain countries are restricted and in some cases prohibited on animal health grounds by the Importation of Animal Products and Poultry Products Order 1980, as amended.
