MID GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

Mid Glamorgan County Council (Miskin Link (A4119) Between Castell Mynach and the Miskin Interchange) (24 Hour Carriageway Clearway) Order 1982.

Notice is hereby given that the Mid Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in any part of the carriageway forming part of that length of the A4119 known as the Miskin Link from the southern side of its junction with that section of the A4119 leading to Groesfaen at Castell Mynach to the northern side of the gyratory carriageway at the Miskin Interchange, a distance of approximately 1,100 metres (1,203 yards). The proposed Order will also prohibit trading from the verges and lay-bys of the carriageway of the length of road in question.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order for the purpose of building or roadworks; the maintenance of essential services; the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office; local authority or water authority vehicles in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; access to adjoining premises whilst a gate or barrier is opened or closed; a requirement of the law, to avoid an accident or for circumstances outside the control of the driver.

A copy of the proposed Order, a statement of the council's reasons for proposing to make the Order and a map showing the length of road to which the proposed Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Taff-Ely Borough Council, Municipal Buildings, Pontypridd, "Danygraig", Llantrisant, and at the Mid Glamorgan County Hall, Cathays Park, Cardiff, during normal office hours.

MID GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

Mid Glamorgan County Council (Ty Isaf Road, Gelli, Rhondda) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that on 14th April 1982 the Mid Glamorgan County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the eastern side of Ty Isaf Road from the southern side of its junction with Ystrad Terrace/Dorothy Street southwards for a distance of 15 metres (16 yards).

Exemptions are provided in the Order for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, building and roadworks, the maintenance of essential services, weddings, funerals and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office. Disabled persons' vehicles displaying the relevant disabled person's badge will be allowed to wait for up to 2 hours with return prohibited within 1 hour.

The Order came into operation on 23rd April 1982 and a copy thereof and a map showing the side of length of road to which the Order relates may be inspected at the

offices of the Mid Glamorgan County Council, Cathays Park, Cardiff, during normal office hours until the end of 6 weeks from 23rd April 1982.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act as so amended or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from 23rd April 1982 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

MID GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

Mid Glamorgan County Council (Glannant Street, Penygraig) (Residents' Parking Places) Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that the Mid Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under sections 28 and 31 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which will be to authorise the use of the side of length of road described in Schedule 1 of this notice as a parking place for residents' vehicles only. ("Resident" means any person whose usual residence is at premises the postal address of which is in any part of the road specified in Schedule II of this notice.) Any such vehicle (passenger vehicle, goods vehicle, dual purpose vehicle, invalid carriage or motor cycle) must display a valid permit issued by the county council in respect of that vehicle. Details of the method of applying for permits will be made known at the appropriate time.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order to allow boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, the maintenance of essential services, roadworks, funerals and weddings and for doctors and veterinary surgeons to visit while "on call".

A copy of the proposed Order, a statement of the council's reasons for proposing to make the Order and a map showing the side of length of road to which the proposed Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Rhondda Borough Council, Municipal Offices, Llewellyn Street, Pentre, and at the Mid Glamorgan County Hall, Cathays Park, Cardiff, during normal office hours.
