

On the west side, from its junction with the west side of Sandhurst Road in an easterly and then southerly direction for a distance of 700 metres.

Sea Lane, Sandilands, on the south side, from its junction with the west side of Sandhurst Road westwards for 31 metres.

- (2) That no person will be allowed to ride or cause to be ridden any pedal bicycle or tricycle on the footpath in Sutton-on-Sea which extends from its junction with South Road in a general easterly direction to its junction with Grove Road.

Exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons vehicles and for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity and water.

The Orders will come into operation on 1st May 1982 and copies thereof, together with plans showing the roads and footpath concerned, may be inspected at the County Offices, Lincoln, and the offices of the East Lindsey District Council, Tedder Hall, Manby, and Victoria Road, Mablethorpe, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within 6 weeks after 21st April 1982, make application to the High Court for that purpose.

LIVERPOOL CITY COUNCIL

The Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) (1980) (Variation No. 2) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of Liverpool under agency arrangements with the Merseyside County Council made the above-named Order under sections 35, 36, 37 and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as subsequently amended, to become operative on 28th April 1982, the effect of which will be to amend the Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone (Liverpool) Order 1980, so as to:

- (1) delete the 2 parking places in Mann Island and Sea Brow;
- (2) delete the following restricted roads: Canning Place (the western carriageway) and Sea Brow;
- (3) amend the no-waiting restriction in certain restricted roads and introduce such a restriction in certain other roads, with the usual exceptions, as described and for the days and times specified in Schedules 1 and 2;
- (4) amend the loading and unloading provisions in certain roads and introduce similar provisions in certain other roads, as described and during the times specified in Schedule 3.

The exceptions referred to will enable a vehicle to wait for so long as is necessary: (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle; (b) to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any wedding or funeral, any building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein; (c) to enable the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes; (d) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said road or lengths of roads; and (e) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle provided that no vehicle (other than a vehicle being used for the purposes of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953) shall so wait between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between 4.30 p.m. and 6 p.m. in the road and lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3 to this notice.

A copy of the Order, the plan and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected at the City Solicitor's Office, Legal and Parliamentary Section, Room 34, Municipal Buildings, Dale Street, Liverpool, between the hours of 8.45 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is

not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as subsequently amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 16th April 1982 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE 1

Roads and parts of roads in which waiting is prohibited between 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays and between 8.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Saturdays

George's Dock Way, from a point 13.7 metres (45 feet) north-west of its junction with Mann Island to its junction with Brunswick Street, all measured along the said road.

Mann Island

- (a) the north-west side, from a point 13.7 metres (45 feet) south-west of its junction with George's Dock Way to its south-western extremity; and
- (b) the south-east side, from its junction with Irwell Street to its south-western extremity, all measured along the said road.

Strand Street

- (a) the north-east side, from a point 13.7 metres (45 feet) south-east of its junction with Redcross Street to a point 130 metres (426 feet) north-west of its junction with the southern carriageway of Canning Place; and
- (b) the south-west side, from a point 165 metres (541 feet) south-east of its junction with Mann Island to a point 50 metres (164 feet) north-west of the vehicular access between Canning Dock and Salthouse Dock, all measured along the said road.

SCHEDULE 2

Roads and parts of roads in which waiting is prohibited 24 hours a day

George's Dock Way, from its junction with Mann Island in a north-westerly direction for a distance measured along the said road of 13.7 metres (45 feet).

Mann Island

- (a) the north-west side, from its junction with Goree to a point 13.7 metres (45 feet) south-west of its junction with George's Dock Way; and
- (b) the south-east side from its junction with Strand Street to its junction with Irwell Street, all measured along the said road.

Park Lane, from its junction with Canning Place in a southerly direction for a distance measured along the said road of 7.62 metres (25 feet).

Strand Street

- (a) the north-east side, from its junction with James Street to a point 13.7 metres (45 feet) south-east of its junction with Redcross Street;
- (b) the north-east side, from its junction with the southern carriageway of Canning Place in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 130 metres (426 feet);
- (c) the south-west side from its junction with Mann Island in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 165 metres (541 feet); and
- (d) the south-west side, from a point 50 metres (164 feet) north-west of the vehicular access between Canning Dock and Salthouse Dock to its junction with Wapping, all measured along the said road.

Wapping, from its junction with Strand Street and Canning Place in a southerly direction for a distance measured along the said road of 7.62 metres (25 feet).

SCHEDULE 3

Roads and parts of roads in which loading and unloading is prohibited between 8.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between 4.30 p.m. and 6 p.m.

Mann Island, from its junction with Goree and Strand Street to its junction with George's Dock Way and Irwell Street.

Park Lane, from its junction with Canning Place in a southerly direction for a distance measured along the said road of 7.62 metres (25 feet).

Redcross Street, from its junction with Strand Street in a north-easterly direction for a distance measured along the said road of 13.7 metres (45 feet).
