Welwyn Hatfield (Cranborne and Endymion Roads, Hatfield) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that the Welwyn Hatfield District Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Hertford, have made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 10 a.m. on Mondays to Fridays along both sides of Cranborne Road and both sides of Endymion Road, including the eastern arm, subject to exemptions:

- Waiting by vehicles in the roads for a reasonable time in connection with a wedding or funeral;
- Parking of vehicles used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes and for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets.

The Order will come into operation on 28th April 1982 and a copy of the Order and plan showing the lengths of road affected may be inspected during normal office hours at the Council Offices, The Campus, Welwyn Garden City, and at 16 St. Albans Road East, Hatfield.
