Duke Street, Droylsden. Duke Street, from its junction with Dunkirk Street running in a south-westerly direction to its junction with Albert Street being a distance of approximately 35 metres.

Unnamed passageway at the eastern gable of 14 Dunkirk Street, Droylsden. The unnamed passageway from its junction with Dunkirk Street running in a south-westerly direction to its junction with Albert Street being a distance of approximately 34 metres.

Unnamed passageway at the rear of 4-14 Dunkirk Street, Droylsden. The unnamed passageway from its junction with Duke Street running in a south-easterly direction to its junction with the passageway at the eastern gable of 14 Dunkirk Street being a distance of approximately 28 metres.

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Orders, made on 7th April 1982 are about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed as unopposed Orders by the Waverley District Council.

(a) The effect of this Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert that part of Bridleway 313 running from a point south of Shamley Wood Cottage and proceeding in a northerly and north-easterly direction to a point east of Shamley Wood Cottage, to a line running from the first point above referred to and proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction to the second point above referred to.

(b) The effect of this Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert that part of Bridleway 313 running from its junction with Footpath 311 north of Shamley Wood House and proceeding in a generally south-easterly direction to a point east of Shamley Wood Cottage, to a line running from the first point above referred to and proceeding in an easterly, generally south-easterly and southerly direction through Reelhall Hill to the second point above referred to.

(c) The effect of this Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert the part of Footpath 314 running from a point south-west of Shamley Wood Cottage and proceeding in a north-easterly direction to a point where the path joins Bridleway 313, to a line running from the first point above referred to and proceeding in an easterly direction to join Bridleway 313 at a point south of Shamley Wood Cottage.

Copies of each of the Orders and the maps contained therein have been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the offices of Waverley District Council, The Bury, Godalming, Surrey, and at the Council's Locality Office, Rowland Road, Cranleigh, Surrey, on Mondays to Fridays during normal office hours.

The North Yorkshire County Council Footpath No. 3 in the Parish of Barden Diversion Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order, made on 12th March 1982 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, or to be confirmed, as an unopposed Order by the North Yorkshire County Council.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert the public right of way known as Footpath No. 3 Barden. The section of footpath to be diverted commences at a point on the river bank in O.S. Field No. 3200 at Grid Reference SE 0530 5800. It proceeds in a generally northerly direction across the field to the boundary wall with O.S. Field No. 3730. It then crosses the wall and continues in the same direction across O.S. Field No. 3730 to Grid Reference SE 0532 5832 which is on the river bank, a total distance of approximately 300 metres. The section of footpath to be created commences at a point on the river bank in O.S. Field No. 3200 at Grid Reference SE 0530 5800. It follows the river bank along the boundary of O.S. Field No. 3200 in a generally north-westerly direction before swinging north-north-easterly along the river bank after approximately 100 metres to reach the boundary wall with O.S. Field No. 3730. The path crosses the wall and follows the river bank of O.S. Field No. 3730 to reach Grid Reference SE 0532 5832.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at The Yorkshire Dales National Park Office, Colvend, Grassington, Near Skipton, North Yorkshire, during normal office hours.

Any representations or objections with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the County Solicitor, North Yorkshire County Council, County Hall, Northallerton, before the 28th May 1982 and should state the grounds on which they are made.

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the North Yorkshire County Council may instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment, themselves confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted with the Order.
