The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Chief Registrar's Office (Bank Buildings) at the Bank of England on Friday, 30th April 1982 at 1 p.m. for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act 1877, and the National Loans Act 1968, to the amount of £100,000,000.
