**Silverdale, Darley Public Path Diversion Order**

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order (hereinafter called "the Order") made on 22nd April 1982 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed by the Council of the Borough of Harrogate as an Unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert that part of the public path running from Main Street, Darley to a point (A on the map attached to the said Order) from thence approximately 35 metres in a north-easterly direction to point F and from thence in a generally south-easterly direction through Silverdale Farm and across the north-eastern boundary of O.S. Field 6942 passing through point E at the south-western corner of O.S. Field 8052 to a line running from the said point A in a northerly direction for approximately 20 metres to point B from thence approximately 30 metres in a north-easterly direction to point C from thence approximately 50 metres in a south-south-easterly direction to point D from thence approximately 30 metres in a south-easterly direction to rejoin the existing path at the said point E.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the Chief Executive's Office, Council Offices, Harrogate, and may be inspected free of charge at that office between the hours of 8.45 a.m. and 4.45 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays.

Any representations or objections with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the Council of the Borough of Harrogate, Council Offices, Harrogate, not later than 7th June 1982 and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made or any so made are withdrawn, the Council of the Borough of Harrogate may, instead of submitting the Order
