

DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under S 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of a length of Loris Road, W.6 to enable public open space development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted by the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham under Part III of the said Act.

The proposed Order will require an improvement of Loris Road by widening.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967: SECTION 1

THE TRUNK ROAD (A51) (BARONY ROAD/
MILLSTONE LANE, NANTWICH)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1981

1. Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 on the North of Newcastle-under-Lyme—Nantwich—Tarpoley—Tarvin Trunk Road (A51) known as Barony Road/Millstone Lane at Nantwich, in the Borough of Crewe and Nantwich, in the County of Cheshire.

2. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting at any time on any day on both sides of the trunk road as specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

3. Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building, industrial or demolition operations; to enable the removal of any obstruction to traffic or the maintenance of the road or the services therein; to enable the vehicle to be used in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of its statutory powers and duties; to enable the delivery or collection of postal packets; or to enable a disabled person's vehicle to wait for up to two hours.

4. A copy of the Order, together with a plan illustrating the proposal and a Statement of Reasons, may be inspected during reasonable hours at the Offices of the Borough Secretary, Crewe and Nantwich Borough Council, Delamere Street, Crewe and at the Information Centre, Beam Street, Nantwich.
