NOTICE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH ORDER
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1971*Public Path (Great Wyrley No. 19 (Part)) Stopping-Up Order 1982*

Notice is hereby given that the above named Order made on 21st May 1982 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed as an unopposed Order by the South Staffordshire District Council.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification will be to extinguish that part of the right-of-way known as Footpath No. 19 Great Wyrley from a point "A" at the paths commencement approximately 12 metres from the rear of number 140 Sutherland Road and running in a generally north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 57 metres to a point "B" on Berwyn Grove, Great Wyrley.

A copy of the Order and map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Codsall, Wolverhampton, during normal office hours Monday to Friday inclusive.

Any representations or objections with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the undersigned before 28th June 1982, and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the South Staffordshire District Council may instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment, themselves confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted with the Order.
