(Bridleway No. 9 Parish of Hepple) Bridleway Diversion Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order made on 29th July 1982, is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, or to be confirmed as an unopposed Order by the Northumberland County Council.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to extinguish the line of Bridleway No. 9 from a point approximately 500 metres from its junction with County Road C181 at Bickerton in a north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 1,207 metres to its connection with Bridleway No. 3 at the Parish boundary. The diversion will run from the same point approximately 500 metres from the junction with County Road C181 at Bickerton in an easterly and then north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 1,094 metres to connect up with Bridleway No. 3 at the Parish boundary.
