

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from 30th July 1982 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Cheltenham Borough Council Public Path (C.H. 55) Diversion Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order made on 4th August 1982 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed by the Cheltenham Borough Council as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert part of footpath C.H. 55 which runs from its junction with Orrisdale Terrace, Cheltenham, in a south and easterly direction around Gottingen Gardens at Sandford Park for about 148 metres from Orrisdale Terrace along the northern boundary of Gottingen Gardens then along the western and southern boundary of Sandford Pool for a distance of approximately 158 metres.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it can be inspected free of charge at the Municipal Offices, Promenade, and the Central Library, Clarence Street, Cheltenham, during normal opening hours.

Any representations or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Town Clerk and Chief Executive, Cheltenham Borough Council, Municipal Offices, Promen-

ade, Cheltenham GL50 1PP, not later than 6th September 1982 and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are made, or if they are made and withdrawn, the Cheltenham Borough Council may, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, themselves confirm the Order as unopposed. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for confirmation any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn, will be sent to the Secretary of State with the Order.
