St. Werburgh Street and
Watergate Street.

At the same time, it is proposed to incorporate a small number of additional restrictions and to make permanent the waiting restrictions contained in the City of Chester (Further Stages of Pedestrianisation) Experimental No. 2 Order 1981.

The new restrictions proposed are as follows:

- (4) To relax the existing "No Waiting at any time" provision on the following length of road to allow limited waiting for periods of 30 minutes during the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. (Monday to Saturday).

Foregate Street, north side, from a point 24 metres east of the east side of Love Street to a point 46 metres east of the east side of Love Street.

The usual exemptions will apply to the restrictions and, in addition, there will be a provision for other exemptions at the discretion of the Council.
