

- (viii) for a circus, fair or similar event,
- (ix) for the conveyance of goods for sale from the vehicles,
- (x) military training operations.

The alternative route is via the A48 George Street, Cardiff Road and A4042 Docks Way, Mendalgief Road (Part) and Watchhouse Parade (Part) and vice versa.

The Order, together with a plan showing the restricted roads, may be inspected at the County Hall, Cwmbran, during normal office hours, (Monday to Friday). The Order will come into operation on 13th September 1982.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 12th August 1982, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

GWYNEDD COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Gwynedd (Various Streets, Llandudno) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Gwynedd propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

When this Order comes into effect, you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle at any time on certain sides of Trinity Square (East); Trinity Avenue and Augusta Street.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading or unloading goods;
- and where necessary, in connection with:
- (c) the maintenance of the road;
- (ch) the supply of gas, electricity, water or other statutory undertaking;
- (d) the exercise of local authority powers and functions;
- (dd) fire brigade, ambulance and police purposes;
- (e) and in certain circumstances when the vehicle is a disabled person's vehicle.

The draft Order, together with a map showing the lengths of roads concerned and a statement of the Council's reasons proposing to make the Order may be examined at the Town Hall, Llandudno during normal business hours.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order, you should send the grounds for your objection to the undersigned by 3rd September 1982.

GWYNEDD COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Gwynedd (Various Streets, Criccieth) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that the Gwynedd County Council, on 12th August 1982, made an Order under section 1 and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

When this Order comes into effect on 16th August 1982, you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle at any time on certain sides of Ednyfed Road, Lon Fel, Radcliffe Road, Ty'n y Grisau Terrace and Cwrt y Maes.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading or unloading goods, taking in petrol, oil, water, or air from any garage, and where necessary, in connection with the maintenance of the roads, the supply of gas, electricity or water and the exercise of local authority statutory powers and duties, and in certain circumstances where the vehicle is a disabled person's vehicle.

Full details are in the Order, which, together with a map showing the restricted areas, may be examined at the County Offices, Shirehall Street, Caernarfon, between 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m., Monday to Friday and at the County Library, High Street, Criccieth.
