Both sides, from western kerb-line of Bent Street for 15 metres in a westerly direction.

North side, for 15 metres on either side of Bradstone Road.

Cheetwood Road

Both sides, for 15 metres in each direction from the junction with Broughton Street.

Both sides, for 15 metres in a northerly direction from the northern kerb-line of Derby Street.

Derby Street

Both sides, from the eastern kerb of Waterloo Road to a point 15 metres in an easterly direction.

North side, for 15 metres on either side of Camberwell Street.

Both sides, from eastern kerb of Bent Street for 15 metres in an easterly direction.

Both sides, from western kerb of Cheetham Hill Road for 15 metres in a westerly direction.

Both sides, from western kerb-line of Bent Street for 15 metres in a westerly direction.

North side, for 15 metres in each direction from the junction with Cheetwood Road.

Each side, for 15 metres in each direction from the junction with Sherborne Street.

Each side, for 15 metres in each direction from the junction with Woolley Street.

Woolley Street

Both sides, for 15 metres in a southerly direction from the southerly kerb-line of Broughton Street.

Both sides, for 15 metres in each direction from the junction with Derby Street.

Knowsley Street

Both sides, for 15 metres in an easterly direction from the easterly kerb-line of Sherborne Street.

Both sides, from the westerly kerb-line of Cheetham Hill Road for a distance of 15 metres in a westerly direction.

Both sides, from the easterly kerb-line of Bent Street for a distance of 15 metres in an easterly direction.

Sherborne Street

East side, for 15 metres in each direction from the junction of Knowsley Street.

West side, for 15 metres in each direction from the junction with Allison Street.

West side, for 15 metres in a northerly direction from the junction of Empire Street. Each side, for 15 metres in each direction from the junction with Broughton Street.

Each side, for 15 metres in each direction from the junction with Derby Street.

If any person wishes to question the validity of this Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by t e Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the date of this notice, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
