WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL

City of Winchester (Footpath between Water Lane and Chester Road) Public Paths Diversion Order 1982

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Winchester City Council may, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, themselves confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for confirmation any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent to the Secretary of State with the Order.
