(7) *The Borough of Fareham (Lower Church Road/Hunts Pond Road, Locks Heath) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1982.*

Lower Church Road, both sides, from its junction with Hunts Pond Road for a distance of approximately 35 metres.

Hunts Pond Road, the eastern side, for a distance of approximately 10 metres either side of its junction with Lower Church Road.

The Orders will contain the usual exemptions.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Orders, or any of the provisions contained in them on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirements of that Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may within 6 weeks of 7th October 1982 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

New Traffic Controls for the County of South Glamorgan

Notice is hereby given that on 7th October 1982, the County Council of South Glamorgan, in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 35, 36, 39 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968, the Local Government Act 1972, and the Road Traffic Act 1974, made Orders, the general effect of which is to impose traffic restrictions on the lengths of road referred to in Column 1 of the Schedule below. The nature of the restriction is shown in Column 2.

The Orders will come into operation on 12th October 1982 or on the date that the necessary lines and signs are placed on site, whichever is the later and their titles are shown in Column 3 of the Schedule.

Copies of the Orders and plans showing the affected areas are available at the address shown below, where they may be examined during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of any of the Orders or any provision contained therein on the ground that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended as aforesaid or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or that any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 7th October 1982 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
