ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of Isle of Wight (School Lane, Newport, IW) (Weight Restriction) Order No. 1 1982

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Isle of Wight in exercise of their powers under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police propose to make an Order the effect of which will be to restrict the weight of vehicles using School Lane, Newport, between the junction with Stapiers Road and the junction with Barton Road to 3 tonnes, laden or unladen, except for access to premises situated immediately adjoining that length of road.

The Order is designed to reduce congestion and delay in the said roads and to facilitate the traffic flow generally in the promotion of road safety.

A copy of the draft Order, this notice and the relevant plan may be inspected between normal office hours at the Reception Desk, County Hall, Newport, Isle of Wight, during the objection period. If you wish to object to the proposed restrictions contained in this notice you should send the grounds for your objection, in writing, to the undersigned not later than 12 noon on Monday, 8th November 1982.

LINCOLN CITY COUNCIL

The City of Lincoln (Carlton Walk Footpath) (Prohibition of Cycling) Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that on 7th October 1982 the Council of the City of Lincoln, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Lincolnshire, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 (2), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with section 84C (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, made the above Order.

The effect of the Order which will come into force on 11th October 1982 will be to prohibit the riding of bicycles on the lengths of footpath in Carlton Walk.

A copy of the Order and plans showing the footpaths affected may be inspected during normal office hours at the Chief Executive's and City Engineer's Departments, City Hall, Lincoln.
