Barnsley Street, both sides, from Park Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 5 metres.

Hardy Street, both sides, from Park Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 5 metres,

Hodges Street, both sides, from Park Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 5 metres.

Kimberley Street, both sides, from Park Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 5 metres.

Park Road Park Road

North side, from a point 15 metres east of Spring-field Road to a point 15 metres west of Gidlow Lane.

North side, from a point 15 metres east of Gidlow Lane to the existing restrictions at the railway bridge.

Stratford Street, both sides, from Park Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 5 metres.

Victoria Avenue, both sides, from Park Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 5 metres.

The Order contains exemptions to permit waiting for The Order contains exemptions to permit waiting for the purposes of boarding or alighting, loading or un-loading (except where prohibited), funerals, building opera-tions or work on or under the lengths of road. Dis-abled persons' vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and a parking disc may wait for up to 2 hours, return prohibited within I hour (except when the loading/ unloading ban is in operation).

A copy of the Order which comes into operation on 25th October 1982 and a map showing the roads to which it relates, may be inspected between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Monday to Friday at:

(a) County Legal Office, County Hall, Piccadilly Gardens, Manchester; or

Director of Administration's Office, Civic Centre, Millgate, Wigan.

Any person who desires to question the validity of this Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks from 29th September 1982, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
