to be built, will be in operation when the appropriate signs 6 a.m., and each subsequent Sunday until such times as the works have been completed.
The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle to:
(a) proceed in the south-west quadrant of the A127/A129

Rayleigh Weir Roundabout; and
(b) proceed in the north-west quadrant of the A127/A129 Rayleigh Weir Rounabout,
are erected on Sunday, 31st October 1982, between 1 and at such times as indicated by traffic signs.
Traffic entering the Roundalbout from all directions will be restricted to a single lane only and controlled by a series of temporary traffic signals. Only one quadrant of the Roundabout will be closed at any one time and traffic may be required to travel at these times in an anti-clockwise direction round the Roundabout.
