- (1) a special road about 9.145 kilometres (5.72 miles) in length from Southgate Road A111, at Potters Bar to the A10 London-Cambridge-Kings Lynn Trunk Road Roundabout at Bullsmoor
 - (2) two special roads as slip roads, for entry to and exit from the above-mentioned special road at Southgate Road A111 at Potters Bar; and
 - (3) two special roads as slip roads, for entry to and exit from the above-mentioned special road at Great

Cambridge Road A10 at Bullsmoor.

In accordance with the requirements of the Highways Act 1980 a formal notice to this effect dated 14th July 1982 was published in the Enfield Independent on 21st July 1982, in the Enfield Advertiser on 22nd July 1982 and in the London Gazette, Enfield Gazette, Cheshunt and Waltham Weekly Telegraph, Lea Valley Mercury and Harley Gazette on 22nd July 1982 Harlow Gazette on 23rd July 1982.

Where a highway open for general purposes is then appropriated for the restricted purposes of a motorway,
