COAST PROTECTION ACT 1949

Notice is hereby given that the District Council of Chichester, acting in their capacity as Coast Protection Authority, hereby give notice under subsection (1) of section 5 of the above Act that they propose to reconstruct Groyne E9, E12, E14, E16, E20, E21, E45 and E46 at East Beach, Selsey. The proposed work is the fourth phase of a continuing programme of reconstruction of the East Beach groyne and the method is similar to that adopted previously. The corroded upper portion of the existing steel sheet piling will be cut down below general beach level and discarded, and a new hardwood walling will be fixed to the top of the sound steel sheet piles. New hardwood main piles will be driven alongside the walling and hardwood planking will be fixed to the new main piles to restore the original groyne profile.

The estimated cost of these works is £130,000.

A copy of a plan showing the precise position of the groyne may be inspected at the offices of the Director of Administration, District Council of Chichester, Greyfriars, North Street, Chichester, during normal office hours, Monday to Friday until 19th November 1982.

Any person may, not later than 19th November 1982, serve a written notice of objection to the above proposal on the Secretary of State for the Environment and on the above mentioned Authority.
