 - (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter Windmill Lane.
 - (b) to stop up lengths of the existing trunk road and lengths of Windmill Lane, Radbourne Lane and public footpaths Nos. SM89, SM90 and SM92A.
 - (c) to construct a new highway (which will be a footpath) to connect Radbourne Lane with the Ladbroke By-Pass;
 - (d) to stop up a length of a private means of access to New House Farm, where it is crossed by the Ladbroke By-Pass;
 - (e) to provide a new means of access to Pool Spinney and Milking Hill Spinney, all at Ladbroke aforesaid, and providing for the transfer of the said new highway to the County Council of Warwickshire as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open.
