The effect of the Order as confirmed is to stop up Footpath No. D.96 which commences at Footpath No. D.182 Six Foot Road approximately 14 metres south of St. John Street, Netherton, at Ordnance Survey Ref. 394245/288138 and proceeds for a distance of approximately 35 metres in a south-easterly direction to join Harrison's Fold at Ordnance Survey Ref. 394262/288109.

*The Dudley Metropolitan Borough (Footpath No. D.182 Six Foot Road, Netherton) Public Path Diversion Order 1982.*

Notice is hereby given that on 14th October 1982 the Borough Council of Dudley confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert that section of footpath D.182 which commences at the rear of the Ebenezer Baptist Church and runs generally in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 24 metres to its junction with St. John Street, Netherton, to a new line running from the rear of the Ebenezer Baptist Church generally in a north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 22 metres to terminate at St. John Street, Netherton, approximately 12 metres east at Grid Ref. 394259/288142.

*Borough of Dudley (Bridleway No. S.1, Wollaston) (No. 2) Public Path Diversion Order 1982*

Notice is hereby given that on 14th October 1982, the Borough Council of Dudley confirmed the above-named Order.
