HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The North Yorkshire County Council Footpath at Kirkbank Farm, Gilling with Hartforth and Sedbury Parish Diversion Order 1980.

Notice is hereby given that on 13th October 1982 the Secretary of State for the Environment confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order, as confirmed is to divert the public right of way commencing in field O.S. 3434 and runs in a generally easterly direction across field O.S. Nos. 3434 and 4830 to point D on the map, a distance of approximately 284 metres to a new route commencing at point C on the map on the existing path in field O.S. No. 3434 and runs south-easterly to pass through a new gate into field O.S. No. 4830 then easterly across that field to re-join the existing path at point D on the map, a total distance of approximately 280 metres.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the map contained in it has been deposited at County Hall, Northallerton, and N.Y.C.C. Divisional Office, 18 Green Howards Road, Richmond, and may be inspected free of charge during normal office hours.

The North Yorkshire County Council Footpath No. 4 in the Parish of Hebden Diversion Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that on 15th October 1982, the North Yorkshire County Council confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order, as confirmed, is to divert the public right of way known as Footpath No. 4 Hebden. The section of the footpath to be diverted commences at a point in O.S. Field No. 339 at Grid Reference SE 0229 6500, and follows the south-easterly side of the wall of Top Mere Lane in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 370 metres. It then crosses a bridge over a small stream and turns south-east for approximately 160 metres to join Bridleway No. 10 in Hebden Gill at Grid Reference SE 0263 6519.

The section of footpath to be created follows Top Mere Lane in a north-easterly direction from Grid Reference SE 0229 6500 for approximately 410 metres. It then turns south-easterly for approximately 60 metres or thereabouts and then north-easterly for approximately 80 metres to join Bridleway No. 10 in Hebden Gill at Grid Reference SE 0265 6534.

A copy of the order as confirmed and the map contained in it has been deposited at the Yorkshire Dales National Park Office, Colvend Grassington, Skipton, North Yorkshire, and may be inspected free of charge during normal office hours.

The Order becomes operative as from 15th October 1982 but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order he may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 15th November 1982 make an application for the purpose to the High Court.

The North Yorkshire County Council Footpath No. 15 Embsay-with-Eastby Diversion Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order, made on 12th October 1982, is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, or to be confirmed, as an unopposed Order by the North Yorkshire County Council.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert the section of footpath which commences at a point in O.S. field No. 8100, at Grid Reference SE 0086 5386, at its boundary with O.S. field No. 9000 and continues in a generally westerly direction crossing the playing field at Embsay Church of England School in O.S. field No. 7887. It then follows the southern boundary wall of O.S. fields Nos. 7400 and 6500 to the boundary wall of O.S. field No. 5800 at Grid Reference SE 0064 5383. The total distance to be diverted is 220 metres.

The section of footpath to be created commences in O.S. field No. 8100 at Grid Reference SE 0086 5386 at its boundary with O.S. field No. 9000. It continues in a generally north-westerly direction across O.S. field No. 8100 to its boundary with O.S. field No. 7400 before turning west across O.S. field No. 7400 following the boundary fence with O.S. field No. 7887 for part of the way until it reaches the boundary with O.S. field No. 6500. The route then turns south-westerly across O.S. field No. 6500 to its boundary with O.S. Field No. 5800 at Grid Reference SE 0064 5383. The total length of footpath to be created is 240 metres approximately.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the Yorkshire Dales National Park Office, Colvend, Grassington, near Skipton, North Yorkshire, during normal office hours.
