ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

AVON COUNTY COUNCIL

Avon County Council (Kings Weston Lane, Lawrence Weston, Bristol) (Weight Restriction) Order 198

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Avon propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit the use of that length of Kings Weston Lane which extends from its junction with Long Cross in a northerly direction for a distance of 961 metres (1,051 yards) by any vehicle which has a maximum gross weight, as defined in Regulation 4 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1981, of 7.5 tonnes and an unladen weight exceeding 3.05 tonnes.

The Order will contain exemptions for any vehicle:

- (a) to be used in connection with the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that length of road;
- (b) to be used for the purposes of agriculture or forestry;
- (c) to be used in connection with the carrying out on, or on premises situated on or adjacent to, that length of road or any of the following operations:
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations,
 - (ii) the removal of obstruction to traffic,
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road,
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the road of any sewer, or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878,
- (d) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
- (e) to proceed to or from any premises which are situated on or adjacent to that length of road and at which the vehicle is to be, or has been garaged, serviced or repaired;
- (f) in the service of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (g) in the ownership of a local authority:
 - (i) whilst operating locally in pursuance of statutory powers or duties, or
 - (ii) to gain access to or egress from the Avonmouth Refuse Disposal Works in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the draft Order, which together with a map and a statement of the council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the undermentioned offices (sixth floor) during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made, must be sent in writing to the undersigned within 21 days of the date of this notice.

CLEVELAND COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Cleveland (C129 Through Road, Hilton Village) (Restricted Roads) Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that on 25th October 1982, the County Council of Cleveland made the above-named Order under sections 72 (3) and 73 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, which will come into operation on 28th October 1982. The effect of the Order will be to impose a speed limit of 30 m.p.h. on the length of road specified in the schedule to this notice.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the restricted road are available for inspection during normal office hours at the offices of the County Secretary, Municipal Buildings, Middlesbrough and the Town Clerk, Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council, Church Road, Stockton-on-Tees.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the date of this notice apply to the High Court for this purpose.

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Gables Road/Somerville Road, Willand) (7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight Limit) Order 1982.

Notice is hereby given that the Devon County Council on 25th October 1982, made an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit the driving of goods vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight along Gables Road, Willand for its entire length, and along Somerville Road, Willand from its junction with Gables Road to its junction with Station Road. The Order will come into force on 1st November 1982. There will be the usual exemptions applicable to the conveyance of goods, persons or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the lengths of road and for the purpose of agriculture on any land adjacent to the roads or in connection with the agriculture on any land adjacent to the roads or in connection with the conveyance of or haulage of timber felled upon the land, building, industrial demolition operations, removal of obstructions to traffic, maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the roads and for statutory purposes, together with fire brigade, police and ambulance emergency requirements.

A copy of the Order and a plan may be inspected during normal office hours at County Solicitor's Department, Room G42, County Hall, Exeter, Devon, and at the Post Office, Willand.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provisions therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any Instrument made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 25th October 1982, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
