LONDON BOROUGH OF REDBRIDGE

Revision of the Ilford and the Gants Hill Controlled Parking Zones

Notice is hereby given that, on the application of the Council of the London Borough of Redbridge, the Greater London Council on 20th October 1982, made:

- (a) the Redbridge (Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 1982 under sections 35, 36, 37, 40 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968; and
- (b) the Redbridge (Free Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 1982 under sections 6 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968 and the Road Traffic Act 1974.

2. The general effect of the Parking Places Order will be to:

- (a) revoke the designation by the Parking Places (Redbridge) Order 1966, the Parking Places (Redbridge) (Amendment) Order 1969, the Parking Places (Redbridge) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1970, the Parking Places (Redbridge) (Amendment No. 3) Order 1972, the Redbridge (Parking Places) Order 1973, the Redbridge (Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 1976, the Redbridge (Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 1976 and the Redbridge (Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 1978 of all the metered parking places within the Ilford and the Gants Hill Controlled Parking Zones;
- (b) designate parking places on the highways specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this notice at which charges may be made by the Borough Council for vehicles authorised by the Order to be left in those parking places;
- (c) provide that the type of parking place, the maximum initial period and the rate of charge in respect of that parking place will be as set out in columns 2, 3 and 4 respectively of the said Schedule 1 and that the excess period and the excess charge (payable to the Borough Council) in respect of the parking places will be 2 hours and £3 respectively, the unexpired time shown on a parking meter may be used free of charge and the period during which a vehicle may not return to a parking place will be one hour;
- (d) provide that the hours of operation of the parking places will be between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive (Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays excepted);
- (e) provide that the vehicles which may be left in the parking places shall be passenger vehicles (12 seats or less), goods carrying vehicles, motor cycles and invalid carriages; and
- (f) provide that certain vehicles may wait free of charge in certain circumstances, e.g. to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes) and vehicles left by specified disabled persons (no time limit).

3. The general effect of the Free Parking Places Order will be to:

- (a) revoke the designation by the Free Parking Places (Redbridge) Order 1967, the Free Parking Places (Redbridge) (Amendment) Order 1969, the Free Parking Places (Redbridge) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1970 and the Redbridge (Free Parking Places) Order 1973 of all the free parking places within the Ilford and the Gants Hill Controlled Parking Zones;
- (b) designate free parking places on the highways specified in Schedule 2 to this notice in which vehicles authorised by the Order may be left for any period during the permitted hours without charge; and
- (c) contain similar provisions to those set out in paragraph 2(d) and (e) above.

4. The restrictions imposed by the Redbridge (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1978 will apply to any area previously designated as a parking place and not re-designated as such, as they apply in the immediate vicinity.

5. A copy of each of the Orders which will come into operation for the purposes of the installation of parking meters and for the placing of traffic signs, etc., on 30th October 1982, and for all other purposes on 1st November 1982, of the Orders referred to in paragraphs 2(a), 3(a) and 4 above (and of the Orders which have previously amended or applied those Orders) and of the maps which indicate each length of street to which the Orders relate can be inspected until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in Room B.21, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB.

6. Copies of the Orders may be obtained from the Council's Transportation and Development Department, Room 578, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB.

7. Any person desiring to question the validity of either of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 or on the ground that any requirement thereof or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to either of the Orders may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
