Borough of Watford (Central Area Controlled Parking Zone B) Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that on 28th October 1982 the Watford Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, with the County Council of Hertfordshire made the above Orders under sections 1 and 35-39 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 (as amended) the effect of which will be to form two controlled parking zones within the area approximately bounded by St. Albans Road, the local Euston to Watford railway line and Beechen Grove.

Zone A will comprise the following roads:
Albert Road North, Canterbury Road, Franklin Road,
Monmouth Road, St. John's Road (part), Shady Lane,
Wellington Road, Westland Road.

Zone B will comprise the following roads:

Cross Street, Derby Road, Duke Street, Earl Street,
Estcourt Road, Gartlet Road, Gladstone Road, Grosvenor

A major feature of the controlled parking zones will be the establishment of a residents' permit parking scheme. Residents living in the roads in Zone A will be able to obtain from the Council permits allowing them to park their vehicles on certain lengths of the roads within that Zone which will be designated as parking places between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays for vehicles belonging to residents, as indicated in the Schedule to this notice.

Similarly, residents of the roads in Zone B will be able to obtain permits allowing them to park their vehicles in designated parking places on roads within that Zone, as indicated in the Schedule to this notice.

The fee for a permit will be £15 per annum.
