County Borough of Wallasey (Stringhey Road/Trafalgar Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1974 (Amendment No. 1) Order 1982.

Notice is hereby given that Wirral Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Merseyside propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84C (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at the times and lengths and sides of the roads specified in the Schedule.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to permit the picking up and setting down of passengers, loading and unloading of goods, in pursuance of statutory powers and duties and disabled persons' parking and hackney carriages to wait on authorised stands.

A copy of the Order, map and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be seen at all reasonable hours at the Department of Administration and Legal Services (Room 16), Town Hall, Wallasey.

2. Rudgrave Square on both sides from its junction with Trafalgar Road for a distance of 15 yards (13.7 metres) in a south-easterly direction.
