NEW TOWNS ACT 1981

NOTICE OF ORDER UNDER SECTIONS 1 AND 77

The Aycliffe New Town (Designation) Amendment Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under sections 1 and 77 of the New Towns Act 1981 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, on 20th October 1982 made an Order varying the Aycliffe New Town (Designation) Order 1947, as already varied by the Aycliffe New Town (Designation) Amendment Order 1966, and by the Aycliffe New Town (Designation) Amendment Order 1974 by adding to the area thereby designated an area of approximately 27 hectares of land on the southern boundary of the designated area lying within the district of Sedgfield in the administrative county of Durham as shown on the map referred to in the Order.

In compliance with the provisions of paragraph 5 of Schedule 1 to the Act a copy of the Order and a copy of the map have been deposited at the following places:

County Hall, Durham;
Sedgfield District Council Offices, Spennymoor;
Aycliffe Development Corporation Office, Churchill House, Newton Aycliffe;
and may be inspected at all reasonable hours.

Copies of the Order and map have also been deposited at the Department of the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London S.W.1, and the Department of the Environment's Northern Regional Office, Wellbar House, Gallowgate, Newcastle-upon-Tyne NE1, where they may be inspected between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on weekdays, except Saturdays.

Copies of the map, on the scale of 1 to 10,000, on which the designated area is shown may be obtained, price £4 per copy, from the following agents of the Ordnance Survey:

Paragraph 6 of Schedule 1 to the New Towns Act 1981 provides that if any person aggrieved by an Order under section 1 of the Act desires to question the validity thereof, or of a provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he may within 6 weeks from the date on which the notice of the making of the Order is first published, make an application to the High Court; and on any such application the Court:

(a) may by interim order suspend the operation of the Order or any provision contained therein, either generally or insofar as it affects any property of the applicant, until the final determination of the proceedings; and

(b) if satisfied that the Order or any provision contained therein is not within the powers of the Act or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirement of the Act not having been complied with may quash the Order or any provision contained therein, either generally or insofar as it affects any property of the applicant.
