The Borough of Bournemouth (Various Roads) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 1975 (Variation) (No. 32) Order 1982.

Notice is hereby given that the Bournemouth Borough Council, acting as agent of the Dorset County Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the said County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

When this Order comes into effect—

- (1) *Curzon Road* will be made into a one-way street in a north-westerly direction between Windham Road and Holdenhurst Road;
- (2) (a) *Spring Road* will be made into a one-way street in a north-easterly direction in the section from Victoria Place to Cleveland Road.
(b) *Spring Road* will be made into a one-way street in a south-westerly direction from Curzon Road to Cleveland Road.

The Borough of Bournemouth (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1981 (Variation) (No. 3) Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that the Bournemouth Borough Council, acting as agent of the Dorset County Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the said County Council, propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and Schedule 5 to the Transport Act 1980.

When this Order comes into effect waiting will be prohibited:

(1) (a) between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. on the south-western side of Windham Road from Northcote Road to a point opposite the northern side of Spring Road.

(b) between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. on the north-eastern side of Windham Road from its junction with Holdenhurst Road to its junction with Spring Road;

(c) between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. on the northern side of Windham Road from a point 61 metres (200 feet) east of Spring Road for a distance of 50 metres (165 feet) in an easterly direction.

(d) at all times on both sides of Windham Road from a point 46 metres (150 feet) west of Cleveland Road to a point 46 metres (150 feet) east of Cleveland Road.

(2) at all times on both sides of Cleveland Road from its junction with Windham Road to its junction with Spring Road.

(3) between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. on the eastern side of Victoria Place from its junction with Windham Road to its junction with Spring Road.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:

(a) picking up and setting down passengers;

(b) loading or unloading goods;

and, where necessary, in connection with:

(c) the maintenance of the roads, and

(d) the supply of gas, electricity and water.
