HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The North-West of Doncaster-Kendal Trunk Road (Airedale Route-Bingley to Kildwick and Link Road) Order 1982.

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 10 of the Highways Act 1980, the effect of which is to: provide that roads which he proposes to construct along the following routes shall become trunk roads as from the date when the Order comes into operation:

- (i) a route (the main route) about 5.23 kilometres (3.25 miles) in length in the Aire Valley in the Metropolitan County of West Yorkshire commencing at Bingley, proceeding in a north-westerly direction through Crossflatts and ending on the A650 at Victoria Park, Keighley (this route including roundabouts to connect with the existing roads at Crossflatts and Keighley);
- (ii) a route (the main route) about 7.04 kilometres (4.37 miles) in length in the Aire Valley partly in the Metropolitan County of West Yorkshire and partly in the County of North Yorkshire commencing at Beechcliffe, Keighley, proceeding in a north-westerly direction passing to the north of Steeton and ending on the A629 Trunk Road north-west of Kildwick (this route including roundabouts to connect with the existing roads at Steeton and Kildwick); and
- (iii) a route for a link road to connect the main roads with the existing A650 trunk road at Crossflatts.
