#### *The Borough Council of Gateshead (No. 14) Smoke Control (No. 2 Variation) Order 1982*

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Gateshead, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 (5) of the Clean Air Act 1956 on 5th November 1982 made an Order entitled "The Borough Council of Gateshead (No. 14) Smoke Control (No. 2 Variation) Order 1982" which varies "The Borough Council of Gateshead (No. 14) Smoke Control (Variation) Order 1980" in respect of the buildings specified in the Schedule hereto which shall not be exempt from the provisions of "The Borough Council of Gateshead (No. 14) Smoke Control Order 1979".

If confirmed by the Secretary of State for the Environment the Order will not come into operation before 1st November 1983 or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State.

#### *Notice of Intention to Make the Borough Council of Gateshead, Wardley (No. 23) Smoke Control Order 1983*

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Gateshead, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above mentioned Act, intend to make the Borough Council of Gateshead, Wardley (No. 23) Smoke Control Order 1983 which will declare the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (2) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The autho-

rised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If made the Order will come into operation on 1st November 1983.
