THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The Shrewsbury-Dolgellau Trunk Road (Dol-y-Maen to Allt-Fraith, Foel Diversion) (Revocation) Order 1982, and

The Shrewsbury-Dolgellau Trunk Road (Dol-y-Maen to Allt-Fraith, Foel Diversion Side Roads) (Revocation) Order 1982.

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 10 and 326 of the Highways Act 1980, providing that the Shrewsbury-Dolgellau Trunk Road (Dol-y-Maen to Allt-Fraith, Foel Diversion) Order 1975 and the Shrewsbury-Dolgellau Trunk Road (Dol-y-Maen to Allt-Fraith, Foel Diversion Side Roads) Order 1975 be revoked.

Any person aggrieved by the Orders and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that they are not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, may within 6 weeks from 7th February 1983, or within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice, if such period shall expire later, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Orders or of any provision contained therein.

THE IMPORTED FOOD REGULATIONS 1968
(AS AMENDED)

Argentina: Official Certificate

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Wales acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Imported Food Regulations 1968 (S.I. 1968, No. 97), as amended by the Imported Food (Amendment) Regulations 1973, 1979 and 1981 (S.I. 1973, No. 1351, S.I. 1979 No. 1426 and S.I. 1981 No. 1085) give notice that they hereby restrict recognition of the Official Certificate reproduced in Part I of the Schedule of the notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 12th August 1982 for the importation of specified fresh meat from Argentina to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

Part II of the notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 12th August 1982 is hereby revoked.
