Notice is hereby given that on 10th March 1983 the Blackpool Borough Council, in exercise of their powers under section 31(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and with the consent of the Lancashire County Council given under section 28(2) of the Act of 1967, made the above-mentioned Order. The effect of the Order will be to vary the scale of charges for the parking places named in column (1) of the Schedule to this notice. Details of the charges which are subject to an increase are given at column (2) of the Schedule.

The Order will come into operation on 28th March 1983 and a copy thereof may be inspected at the offices of the Town Clerk, Town Hall, Blackpool, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act of 1967 as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 18th March 1983 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
