SCHEDULE

That length of the St. Clears to Pembroke Dock Trunk Road (A477) at Redberth in the County of Dyfed, which extends from a point 438 metres south-west of its junction with the C3040 road, and continues in a general north-easterly direction to a point 182 metres north-east of that junction. (15 SI)

The Trunk Road (A48) (Castleton, Gwent) (Prohibition of Traffic) Order 1983

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, which shall come into operation on 11th April 1983. The effect of the Order will be:

(1) to prohibit any vehicle proceeding in a westerly direction in that length of the London to Fishguard Trunk Road (A48) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road") at Castleton in the County of Gwent from making a right-hand turn:

(a) into the unnamed access road leading to the Garden Centre which lies approximately 400 metres in a north-easterly direction from the junction of the trunk road with Marshfield Road, Castleton; and

(b) into the unnamed access road leading to the Garden Centre which lies approximately 260 metres in a north-easterly direction from the junction of the trunk road with Marshfield Road, Castleton.

(2) to prohibit any vehicle proceeding in a westerly direction in that length of the trunk road at Castleton to enter the eastbound carriageway at the point opposite the junction of the trunk road with the unnamed road leading to Walk Farm, Castleton.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan and statement of reasons for making the Order, may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of the Borough of Newport, Civic Centre, Newport, Gwent, during a period of 6 weeks from 25th March 1983.

Copies of the Order may be obtained, free of charge, on application to the Welsh Office, Transport and Highways Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, quoting ref. TRPC 15/3/2.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks of 25th March 1983, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein. (4 SI)

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 to authorise the stopping-up of the highways described in the Schedules to this notice to enable development to be carried out.

Copies of the Order may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours at the offices of the Cardiff City Council, City Hall, Cardiff.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he may, with 6 weeks of 7th April 1983 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

SCHEDULE 1

The lengths of highway to be stopped up are at Cardiff in the County of South Glamorgan and are:

(1) That length of Tredegar Street which extends from its junction with Hayes Bridge Road in a south-westerly direction to its junction with Mill Lane.

(2) That length of Hope Street which extends from its junction with Tredegar Street in a southerly direction to its junction with Custom House Street.

(3) That length of Charlotte Street which extends from its junction with Hayes Bridge Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 24 yards.

(4) That length of New Street which extends from its junction with Hayes Bridge Road in a south-westerly direction then south-easterly direction to its junction with Tredegar Street.

(5) That narrow strip of highway on the north side of Custom House Street which extends from its junction with Hope Street for a distance approximately 25 yards.

SCHEDULE 2

That small triangular shaped area of highway with a maximum width of 4½ feet which lies at approximately 23 yards north-east of the Bute Monument. (3 SI)
