## ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

### CLEVELAND COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County Council of Cleveland (Byway No. 1B Seaton) (Prohibition of Vehicular Traffic) Order 1983*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Cleveland in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1) (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police propose to make an Order the effect of which will be as follows:-

(i) to prohibit any vehicular traffic proceeding along the byway No. 1B Seaton in either direction for a distance of approximately 73 metres from its junction with right of way No. 1A to the metal road at the Zinc Works known as Zinc Works Road.

(ii) exemptions to the above will be the Tees and Hartlepool Port Authority, Seaton Golf Club and their Licensees, agents or servants.

### GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Greater Manchester County (Yorkshire Street/Baillie Street/New Buildings Place, Rochdale) (Prohibition of Driving) (Experimental) (County) Order 1981*

Notice is hereby given that on 11th April 1983, the Greater Manchester County Council made an Order under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and Schedule 7 to the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980, the effect of which is to implement on an experimental basis for a maximum period of 18 months the following restriction:-

To prohibit all vehicles at any time from the lengths of road specified below, except that vehicles requiring access to premises will be allowed entry before 11 a.m. on any day and after 5 p.m. on any day:-

Yorkshire Street from The Butts to Acker Street;  
Baillie Street from Yorkshire Street to Constantine Road; and  
New Buildings Place from Baillie Street for a distance of 30 metres in a northerly direction.

The Order which comes into operation on the 18th April 1983 contains exemptions to allow the vehicles of the emergency services and statutory undertakers, certain Local Authority vehicles, vehicles required in connection with building operations and certain vehicles driven by the disabled and issued with a special permit to enter the lengths of road at any time.

Existing Orders will be suspended in whole or in part where they conflict with the Experimental Order.

A copy of the Order and a plan showing the lengths of road to which it relates and copies of the existing Orders may be inspected between 8.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Monday to Friday at the County Legal Office, County Hall, Piccadilly Gardens, Manchester or at the Information Office, Rochdale Borough Council, New Municipal Buildings, Smith Street, Rochdale.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 11th April 1983, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
